Students from FIU, MDC, Nova, and around Miami-Dade will come together for two events that will work to promote anti-genocide social activism. On April 8th, a panel discussion moderated by Dr. Oren Stier will feature Holocaust survivor Joe Sachs, Rabbi Solomon Schiff and FIU Assistant Professor of Law Hannibal Travis, plus a sneak preview of film footage from the "Survivor Project," a social action campaign promoting increased communal responsibility and awareness. On April 9th, John Prendergast, co-founder of the Enough project, noted author, former Clinton administration director of African Affairs at the National Security Council and special advisor at the Department of State, will discuss the current situation in Darfur and the Democratic Republic of Congo and the concrete steps students can take to be part of the solution in bringing peace in both regions.
