Ambassador Haim Waxman is Deputy Permanent Representative of the Mission of Israel to the United Nations. He is a career diplomat. Prior to his current posting, he served as the Director of the Department for Non-Proliferation in the Strategic Affairs Division of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He also served as interim Acting Deputy Director- General for Strategic Affairs. While heading the Department for Defense Export Controls in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs between 2005 and 2007, Ambassador Waxman was closely involved in the reform of the national system of export controls and legislation. During this period, he was a member of the United Nations Group of Experts on Illicit Brokering in Small Arms and Light Weapons.
